## GINGIN SECURES FIRST KEY WASTE DISPOSAL AGREEMENT

M8 Sustainable Limited (“M8S” or “the Company”) is pleased to announce that its wholly owned subsidiary, Fernview Environmental Pty Ltd, today executed a waste disposal agreement with Brajkovich Demolition & Salvage (WA) Pty Ltd (BDS) in relation to M8S’ Gingin Landfill Facility (“Gingin” or “the Facility”). Pursuant to the 5-year agreement, BDS has undertaken to supply to Gingin a minimum of 40,000 tonnes and up to 60,000 tonnes of waste per calendar year.

BDS is one of WA’s largest demolition and salvage businesses and has been providing demolition services for more than 40 years.

Gingin is the Company’s fully permitted landfill with an approved capacity of 150,000 tonnes per annum. The Facility is approved to receive Class II putrescible waste, when the operating license is granted. The current Works Approval also allows the Company to seek approval for a Class III License to allow M8S to receive certain hazardous waste. Once in operation, the Facility will focus on bio-degradable household and commercial waste streams and also generate bio-gas through the accelerated breakdown of organics in the bio-reactor cell allowing M8S to produce renewable energy in due course.

An application to obtain an operating license for Gingin was recently lodged with WA’s Department of Water & Environmental Regulation (DEWAR). (See ASX announcement 29 March 2022). The application is currently being reviewed by DEWAR and it is anticipated that an operating license will be issued following this review subject to any conditions set by DEWAR and completion of construction works.

Works at Gingin are planned to be completed by the end of April 2022 provided that there are no delays to any critical supplies.

Following the signing of the BDS agreement, Mr Tom Rudas, M8S Managing Director, said “This is an exciting development for the Company as it places Gingin on the path to achieving its targeted tonnage of waste. There is a shortage of landfill facilities, especially in Perth’s Northern Metropolitan Corridor, and we think Gingin will be a very strategic asset.”
